## CNA Conference and Trade Show (CNA2018) Student Participation Program FAQ

### What is the CNA Conference and Trade Show, exactly?

It is three days in Ottawa, meeting with nuclear industry execs, and listening to some of the industry's top talent share their knowledge and experience. It's a great opportunity for students considering a career in the nuclear industry to learn more about what we do, to learn about the big developments in the industry and most importantly to meet key contacts.

### Am I eligible to apply?

If you are currently studying at a recognized Canadian post-secondary education institution, then yes!

### How do I apply?

To be selected for the Student Participation Program, you must accept a simple essay writing challenge. Write a 250 word (max) response describing: ***Describe two ways the nuclear industry could best communicate its benefits to younger generations.*** You will also be required to submit a post on either Facebook or Twitter to promote that you have applied and grow awareness among your potentially interested peers.

### What is the deadline to apply for the Student Participation Program?

Applications are due by 11:59PM EST November 30, 2017. Applications received after this date and time will not be considered.

### Is there a student tour to the Canadian Nuclear Laboratories, again this year?

Unfortunately, we will not be holding a CNL tour this year. If we replace the tour with another activity we will let the students know the details as soon as possible.

### How are essays evaluated?

Your essay will be read by an internal committee of CNA staff. We're going to be looking for sound ideas and innovative responses; for a touch of personality, for passion for the industry and the future of nuclear technology; and for the basics of good presentation and writing skills!

**Are there other selection criteria?**

Yes. Our final selections will be submitted to the Deans and Administrators of your institution to confirm your eligibility to attend. Your school may elect to restrict you from attending if you are not a student in good standing, or for any other reason they deem important.

**When will winners be notified?**

The top 100 essays will be selected and winners notified by December 31, 2017.  
Students not selected will still be eligible to register at the regular student rate of \$330.00.

**How do I submit my application?**
