CNA2019 Student Participation Program FAQ

What is the CNA Conference and Trade Show (CNA2019), exactly?

CNA2019 is the premier nuclear industry event in Canada. It is three exciting days of networking with senior executives, learning from expert speakers and creating important business connections. It is a great opportunity for students interested in a career in nuclear to learn about major industry developments, future trends and career opportunities.

Am I eligible to apply?

If you are a registered student at the time of the event and currently studying at a recognized Canadian post-secondary education institution, then yes!

How do I apply?

To be selected, you must write a 250-word (max) response to the question: **Describe a ‘new nuclear’ project you think will change the future and outline the changes it will bring.** You are also required to submit a post on either Facebook or Twitter to promote that you have applied to attend and grow awareness among your interested peers.

What is the deadline to apply for the Student Participation Program?

Applications are due by November 30, 2018 at 11:59PM EST. Applications received after this date and time will not be considered.

How do I submit my application?

Submissions will be accepted online only. Visit CNA2019 and select the ‘Student Registration’ option on the right-hand menu. Applications will be accepted in both English and French.

How are essays evaluated?

Your essay will be evaluated by an internal committee of CNA staff who will be looking for sound ideas and innovative responses, passion for the industry and the future of nuclear technology, a dash of personality and the basics of good presentation and writing skills.

Are there other selection criteria?

Yes. Our final selections will be submitted to the Deans and Administrators of your institution to confirm your eligibility to attend. Your school may elect to restrict you from attending if you are not a student in good standing, or for any other reason they deem important.

Is there a student tour of Chalk River Laboratories this year?

Unfortunately, there will not be a tour this year. If this changes, we will let students know the details as soon as possible.

When will winners be notified?

The top 100 essays will be selected, and winners notified by December 14, 2018. Students not selected will still be eligible to register at the regular student rate of \$345.00.
