## About the program

The program pairs Indigenous leaders with designated Ambassadors, who are industry professionals with expertise in nuclear topics and strong experience in Indigenous engagement. Leaders within the cohort are typically Chiefs and equivalent titles, though delegates may also be accepted.

Each Leader is supported by their Ambassador throughout the conference as they attend programming and meetings with political representatives and organizational or utility leadership.

## Frequently asked questions

### 1. How do I get an invitation?

Reach out to the CNA at the emails below to express interest or to nominate a Chief or Leader. Space is limited, but equal opportunity across Canada is prioritized.

### 2. What if a Leader cannot allocate funds?

CNA's intent is to encourage inclusion while eliminating financial barriers. This program covers travel, accommodations, incidentals, and conference registration. Expenses are paid directly by CNA or reimbursed after the event. Please keep all receipts.

### 3. Who organizes travel logistics?

Chiefs and Leaders are encouraged to book their own travel for comfort and flexibility. CNA reimburses travel after the program. CNA will be responsible for organizing hotel reservations.

### 4. Can Advisors accompany Chiefs or Leaders?

CNA typically cannot reimburse additional party members. Advisors may register at the Indigenous attendee rate if registration is open, and CNA can try to coordinate hotel reservations at the same property.

### 5. What if a participant needs to withdraw?

Please notify the CNA as soon as possible. Even close to the start date, it may be possible to reallocate the space to another interested party.
